Dear participant,

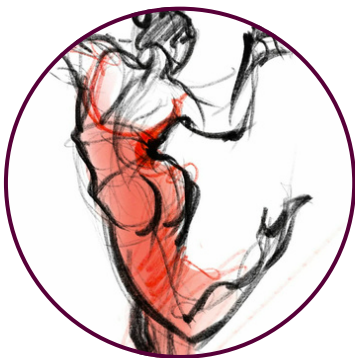
We are currently deep into the detailed planning of the festival, and a growing team of dedicated volunteers is coming together - excited and ready to welcome you.

"I paint with acrylics, which allows me to keep working in layers until the piece feels complete - sometimes resulting in richly textured, almost heavy surfaces. My favorite subjects are people and horses - expressions of life and movement. Tango inspires me deeply: a seductive dance filled with vibrating erotic tension, carrying a dramatic intensity in both movement and music"

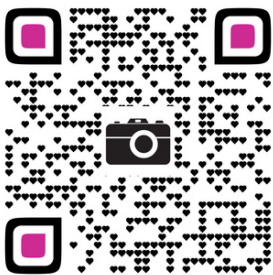
Status on tickets
